



USER GUIDE MINI-PIRINEU

This model has been designed and built exclusively for PELLETARAN. The MINI PIRINEU model is based on previous designs, but is a significant improvement and is a guarantee for quality.

The MINI PIRINEU comes with an independent base which measures 6mm with reinforcements reaching 12mm on the central axle and sides. The structure cannot be deformed.

Easy to ignite and re-load. Good vision of the flames.

The MINI PIRINEU is a perfect basket to burn pellets.

Although pellets are made of wood, they have distinct characteristics to the wood which we normally use in the fireplace. The principal difference being that the pellets should burn FROM THE TOP to the bottom.

STARTING

First, place the MINI PIRINEU on the base of the fireplace with the open part facing to the exterior.

Load with pellets using a metal shovel or similar instrument.

Place two or three fire starting cubes or gel on top of the pellet load.

Never use flammable liquids.

Ignite the cubes and open the primary air entrance of your fireplace or stove.

The air will pass through the MINI PIRINEU which will improve the burning efficiency.

When the pellet load is burning, partially close the primary air entrance to prolong the duration of the fire. If smoke appears, there is a lack of air and the primary air entrance should be opened more fully until the flames return.

The duration of the fire will vary in function of the air circulation and the quantity and quality of the pellets. With correct regulation you can expect to consume approximately 1'3 Kg / H.

The pellets burn with a flame and no smoke.

RE-LOADING

To add new pellets you should remove the coals and ashes with an iron shovel or similar tool. Load the pellets on the coal free part of the grate.

The contact of just a few pellets with the coals is sufficient for the fire to continue. Simply open the primary air entrance until flames are visible.

The ashes are minimal (<2%) and hardly disturb the air combustion process. The following day you can start another fire as well. Removing the ashes every three days will suffice.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

Follow the instructions of the fireplace or stove manufacturer.

Regularly clean and maintain the chimney to avoid overheating.

Use heat resistant gloves to handle the PIRINEU 2.0.

Always have an ABC type extinguisher or a bucket of sand available.
